

How to earn 'A's and create academic success.

- Sit in front of the class
- Listen more than write
- Ask the teacher to review your paper before the deadline
- Meet all of the deadlines
- Plan on studying two to three times the class time for a college class. High school students will need to study 45 minutes per night for core subjects
- If you do poorly on a test-ask to do a re take
- If you must miss a class, ask what you will be missing
- Schedule a break in the day- stay at school and study between classes (college)
- Register as early as possible
- Check your teachers on "Rate my Professor. Com"
- Switch at the beginning of the semester if a class is not right for you
- Overschedule your semester, then drop your least favorite or least needed class (college)
- Know the deadline for dropping classes without penalty.

***At many schools the pass rate for mathematics is less than 50%. GET regular tutoring session set up from the beginning at least once per week and set up a study group with classmates. Study together.
