Who can take a class at Math Support?

However, In order to take a course at MSS during the school year we require that you obtain your counselor or principal's approval. You will need to express a valid reason why your son or daughter cannot take the District course. Such as your son or daughter:

- Has an IEP or 504 and would benefit by receiving individualized instruction due to a learning disability or attention deficit problems
- Has a scheduling issue and cannot attend the district course
- Are a junior or senior and need to finish a course to stay on track for college admissions
- Your child has completed 20 credits to graduate and wants to drop out of the math sequence at school due to anxiety issues with mathematics
- Need to take a course that is not offered at the school,
Such as Algebra 2A/Trig during spring semester or Chemistry B in the Fall semester
- Have tried to pass the course and were unsuccessfully at your school
- You need to take the course to get back on track for college admissions but your school does not offer it ie. Geometry 1A but your school only has Geometry A

IF you have any questions regarding your child's eligibility please call the office and we will be happy to discuss your particular circumstances with you.
